

Tasted by: Charles Curtis MW (at Burgundy, 20 Nov 2024) Drinking Window: 2025 - 2035

Offers lovely grapefruit and nectarine aromas on the initial attack, with a hint of white flowers and smoky reduction. The texture is rich but balanced by crisp acidity. The grapes are from 0.7ha above premier cru Chapitre planted in white marl soils; they are pressed as whole clusters and aged in cask, 25% new. This should be ready to drink shortly after release and will hold up to mid-term ageing.

Displays ripe pear and apricot aromas with a hint of white blossoms. The texture is ripe and round, but there is enough freshness to carry this to a pleasant finish. The grapes are from almost a hectare above the La Crée climat; they are harvested by hand, pressed as whole clusters and fermented on native yeasts in cask, 25% new. The result is a delightful wine ready to drink on release.

Tasted by: Charles Curtis MW (at Burgundy, 20 Nov 2024) **Drinking Window:** 2025 - 2035

Boasts more citrus and pear than stone than many offerings from the Côte Chalonnaise. The texture is rich but not heavy and retains a lively acidity and length. The grapes are from the relatively large premier cru at the top of the slope; it is exposed to the south, but composed of thin soils over a firm limestone base, so it ripens well but retains a bright minerality. This wine is the best of the Rully premiers crus from Belleville.

Tasted by: Charles Curtis MW (at Burgundy, 20 Nov 2024) Drinking Window: 2025 - 2030

Displays exotic aromas of passion fruit and melon with an edge of spice on the initial attack; with time, there is also a suggestion of flinty minerality. The texture is round and supple, enlivened by a burst of freshness that leads into a lingering finish. The grapes are from 0.5ha on the border with Rully (the estate also produces a red Rully Villerange). The grapes are lightly crushed, settled overnight and gently pressed before ageing in cask, 25% new.

Forward, perfumed fruit with aromas of raspberry and pomegranate accented with mint. The texture is light and easy, and it is more focused on perfume than weight. The grapes are from 1.94ha spread over two parcels, one exposed to the north and one to the east; they are gently fermented with just a single punch down and the wine is aged a year in cask, 30% new. This will be ready to drink on release.

Tasted by: Charles Curtis MW (at Burgundy, 20 Nov 2024) Drinking Window: 2025 - 2035

The village-level Champ Roin offers more depth and a classic Mercurey profile with a lovely, sweet cherry fruit aroma and a floral edge on the initial attack, leading into a medium body, firm tannins and a lingering finish. The grapes are from a north-facing parcel of 0.88ha planted in clay soils. The grapes are gently fermented with two pump overs daily and aged in cask, 35% new. This can be drunk on release but will benefit from a couple of years of cellaring.

Slightly closed on the initial attack but opens up with curranty fruit and notes of cedar and earth. The texture is grippy and taut, with lively acidity, producing a slightly rustic effect. The grapes are from 0.41ha at the base of the slope in iron-rich soils, which have produced a wine that will likely improve in two or three years and drink over the next decade.

This seductive wine offers pomegranate and black cherry aromas, accented with notes of earth, spice and smoke. The texture is supple and approachable but not lacking structure. The grapes come from a monopole clos of 1.36ha; the central block has vines at least 70 years of age (the balance will be replanted); but this is only the old-vine material. Although this is classified as a village appellation, the east-facing vines are well placed for ripening grapes.
