
## THIS "CLIMAT"

In 1548, this large plot belonged to the bishops (evêque in French) of Chalon and kept the name "Clos L'Evêque"

### TERROIR

Terroirs: Clay-limestone terroir with a predominance of limestone over the entire slope which makes it both wonderfully balanced and delightfully complex. Care: Variable pruning to reflect requirements of the top, middle and bottom of the slope







### TASTING

Appearance: Nice deep profound ruby robe, limpid and brilliant

Bouquet : Open and pleasant aromas of wild red and black berries (blackberries)

highlighted with peppery notes

In the mouth: Powerful and firm, nicely balanced, full of fruits with a long

finish
