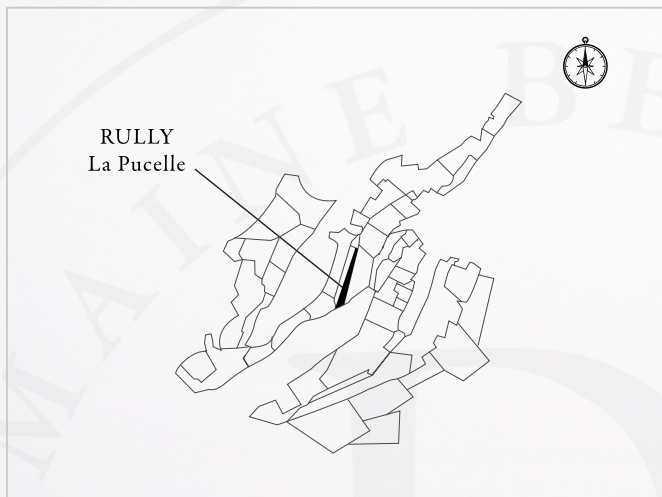
The origins of the name date back to the Middle Ages. The story claims that the Seigneur de Rully divided up his lands and gave his youngest daughter his very best plot. "La Pucelle" comes from the Latin adjective "Pulcella", which can be translated as "Pretty, beautiful, charming"

Terroir: One of the most beautiful Premiers Cru terroirs in Rully, an east-facing slope, very stony

Care: No specific care; the vine grows harmoniously and naturally without excessive growth.

Appearance : Nice light yellow gold robe with tints of green. Limpid and brilliant

Bouquet : Expressive bouquet of butter and fruits such as citrus fruits and white flesh fruits

In the mouth : Nice structure and very well balanced with a surprising mellowness. Flavors of toasted bread and beauty mineral on the finish.
